Time For Quick Cash

Owners of two-year-olds purchased in last year's Ruidoso Select Quarter Horse Yearling Sale have the opportunity for a quick return on their investments if those purchases qualify for the Grade 1, \$266,000 West Texas Futurity from Friday's 10 trials at Sunland Park.

Heartswideopen and Wild Six are two sale graduates in the trials who have already come through for their new owners by breaking their maidens at first asking at Sunland Park last month.

Heartswideopen (Feature Mr Jess-Dashing Phoebe, Dash For Cash) raced the fastest 300-yard time by a two-year-old this spring at Sunland Park when she zipped the distance in :15.21 on March 9 for trainer Carl Draper. The daughter of two-time champion Dashing Phoebe is owned by Javier Rodriguez and was purchased from the consignment of Dreams Come True Ranch on a bid of \$60,000. The filly has the breeding to excel in early-season futurities since her dam won the 1985 runnings of the Sun Country Futurity at Sunland Park and the Kansas (now Ruidoso) Futurity at Ruidoso Downs.

Heartswideopen drew the eighth post position in the fourth trial and Oscar Hernandez will ride.

Wild Six (Tres Seis-Wild Vines, The Signature) broke her maiden on March 3 by a three-quarter-length margin in :15.45 for 300 yards. She was purchased by Herman Mineer and Lee Sherwood for \$32,000 out of the MJ Farms consignment. The Wes Giles trainee is out of a winning half-sister to New Mexico Breeders Derby winner Arbor Mist and All American Futurity finalist Love That Chapelle.

Wild Six has the three hole in the third trial with Tony Guymon aboard. The West Texas Futurity finals will be held on April 22.

Ruidoso Downs Stakes and Condition Book Now Available Online
