Stolis Winner Morning-Line

Favorite for All American Futurity

RUIDOSO DOWNS, New Mexico (August 30, 2008) – Fastest-qualifier Stolis Winner is the 5-2 morning-line favorite for Monday's 50<sup>th</sup> Grade 1 All American Futurity at Ruidoso Downs. Worth \$1.9 million, the All American at 440 yards will award \$1 million to the winner.

A homebred racing for Jerry Windham of College Station, Texas, Stolis Winner is bidding for his eighth consecutive victory and his third Grade 1 win. The Stoli gelding won the Grade 1 Heritage Place Futurity on June 1 at Remington Park and captured the Grade 1 Rainbow Futurity on July 20 at Ruidoso. He has won six of seven races and earned \$789,467 to rank as the year's leading earner in American Quarter Horse racing.

Jockey G.R. Carter Jr., who won the Futurity in 1998 on Falling In Loveagain, will ride Stolis Winner for trainer Heath Taylor. Taylor also will send out 3-1 second choice Jess Zoomin and 20-1 pick Mighty Corona.

The Futurity qualifiers, in post position order with their jockeys and morning-line odds, are: Iamasurebet, Alex Baldillez Jr., 20-1; Jess Significant, Bonifacio Perez, 5-1; Jet Black Patriot, Jose Vega, 7-2; Stolis Winner, G.R. Carter Jr., 5-2; Mighty Corona, Abdel Torres, 20-1; Winners Version, Ramon Sanchez, 15-1; Jess Zoomin, J.R. Ramirez, 3-1; Burner On, Chris Zamora, 20-1; Calif Fugitive, Larry Payne, 9-2; and This Wager Is Hot, Jose Alvarez, 20-1.

The 10<sup>th</sup> of 12 races on the Monday card, the All American has an approximate post time of 4:45 p.m. Mountain time.
